Isle of Wight Residential Trip Monday 15th June to Friday 19th June 2020

A reminder that the deposit for the five day residential trip at the Kingswood Centre, Isle of Wight in June 2020 has to be paid by Friday 13th September to confirm the number of children going on the trip to retain the booking. We are very fortunate to have secured a booking as it is an extremely popular venue with school groups.

For parents who are new to Kingswood, they are a leading residential activity centre provider, responsible for delivering safe and rewarding educational programmes to over 130,000 children every year. By combining many National Curriculum-linked modules with thrilling outdoor and indoor adventure activities, this trip is sure to provide your child with a wealth of new experiences outside of the classroom.

Residential courses organised by the school are, of course, an optional but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Pupils benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that the Adventure Choice and Water programme which we have chosen this year will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile.

We would like to offer this opportunity to the group of pupils from the present Year 6. The trip will take place from **Monday 15th June to Friday 19th June 2020**. The estimated cost of the visit will be **£437.00** and includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities. How you pay is flexible, you can pay the full amount in one go, each payment by the deadline date, or small regular payments (e.g. weekly) to cover the full cost. To confirm our booking, an initial non-refundable deposit of (**£125.00**) will be required by **Friday 13th September 2019**.

The deadline for the second payment of **£125.00*** is **Friday 8th November 2019**

The deadline for the third and final payment of **£187.00*** is **Friday 6th March 2019**

Please beware that these are reliant on how many children pay the deposit to go – this may bring the cost of the overall trip up or down for each individual child.

We will have arranged a parents evening nearer to the trip on **Monday 2nd October at 3:30pm in Redwood Class**: to present to you in more detail the exciting range of activities available at our destination of choice.
